



Notice of Teaching

Non-Practising Registration

Teachers with Non-Practising Registration can use this notice to notify the Teacher Registration Board of Western Australia (TRBWA) that they have started to teach.

Teachers with Non-Practising Registration must advise the TRBWA that they have commenced teaching within 14 days of their first teaching day.

Teaching is defined as to undertake duties in an educational venue that include —

- a) the delivery of an educational programme designed to implement a prescribed curriculum and the assessment of student participation in such an educational programme; or
- b) the administration of any such educational programme.

Please note: The requirement to lodge a Notice of Teaching also applies to teaching in a relief or casual capacity.
