The exceptional circumstances provision is generally intended to address the rare circumstances where a native or near-native English language user has not completed their teacher education in one of the prescribed English-speaking countries.

This may include, but is not limited to, information relating to a person's educational and employment history in an English-speaking environment, references attesting to the applicant's level of English language and interactions with the applicant during the application process.
